## Rules

Coaches can only get points from one player each year.
Each player who gives points to coaches has to play at least one Pancyprian tournament that same year.
If two players have the same points the one with the highest ranking will considered higher.
The coach has to be in good terms with CTF. National team coaches are exempted except only if they are Davis Cup/Fed Cup captains and fall in the distinction rules above.
Doubles distinctions are calculated in the combined rankings for ITF and TE. M en's and Ladies events will carry $50 \%$ of the points of singles listed above.
